

TWICE Board of Directors' Award

Purpose: To recognize a group or organization that has made a significant contribution to the growth of distance learning (specifically two-way interactive video) for students, teachers, and /or staff.

Criteria: Awarded to a group or organization that has made an outstanding contribution toward, or development of, a program or project that has prompted the advancement of distance learning in education.

Rules:

1. This award will be presented to a group or organization. This may include but is not limited to: vendors, distance learning content providers, non-profit organizations, and state-wide organizations.
2. This award will be presented at the TWICE Annual Meeting at the MACUL conference.
3. The nomination is limited to 500 words in length.
4. No group or organization may receive the award more than once.
5. The TWICE Awards Committee will select the recipient from the nominations.
6. Completed nominations must be emailed to the current Awards Chairperson. See TWICE website for contact information.
7. The nomination must be made by a member of TWICE. A seconding of the nomination is encouraged but not required for the nominee to be considered for the award.
8. Nominations must be received by December 1 of the current year. Recipients will be chosen by January 1.
9. Upon selection of the recipient, the committee will notify all of the nominators.
